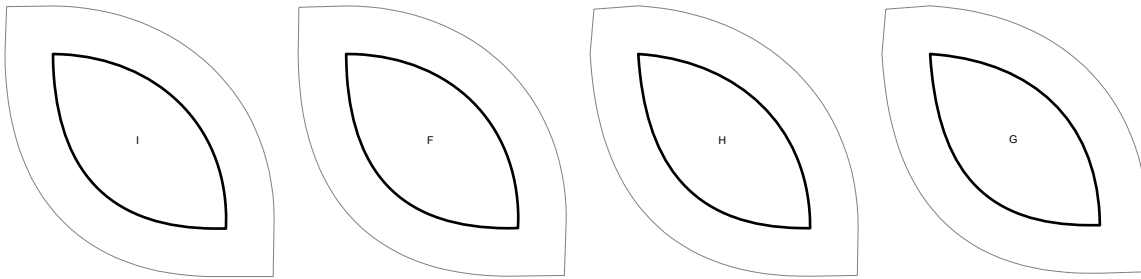
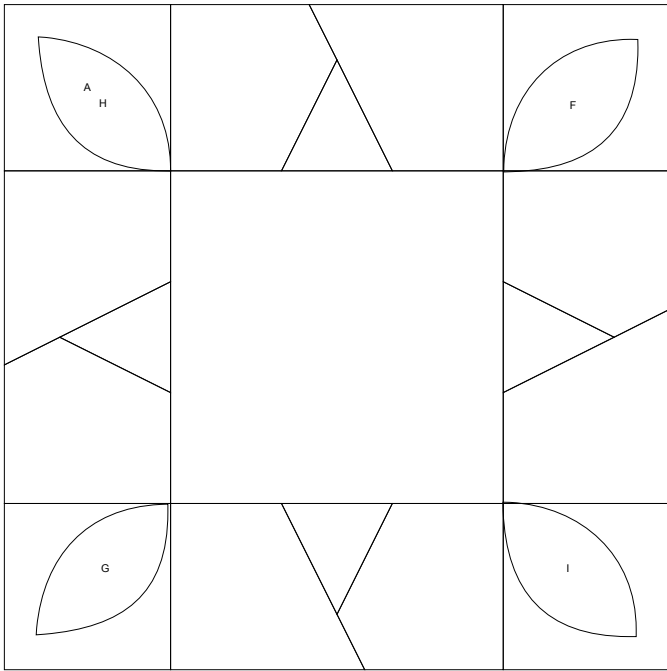
I have redrawn this block to be more like Jane's. After foundation piecing each section and then sewing the sections together, appliqué the melon shapes to the corners.
