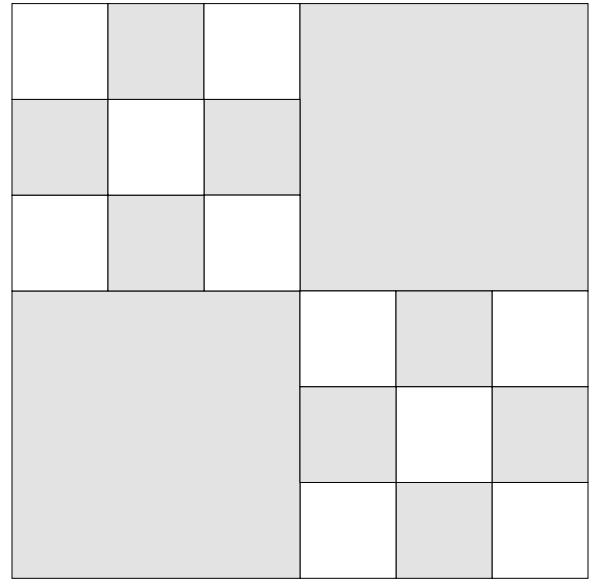
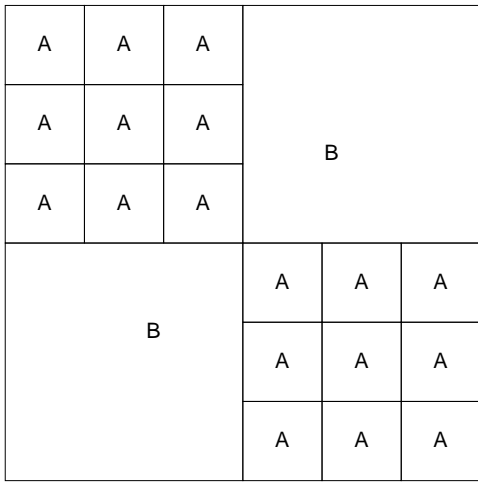
From the background cut 10 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. From focus fabric, cut 8 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " squares and 2 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Assemble the 2 nine patch sections, then assemble the rest of the block as a 4 patch. Very easy.



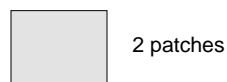
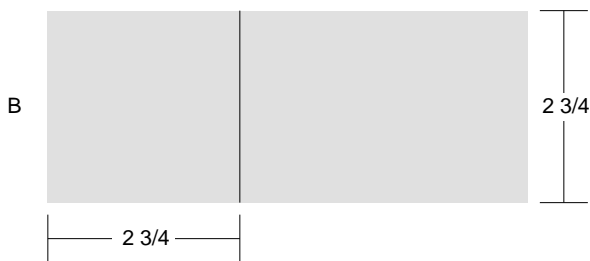

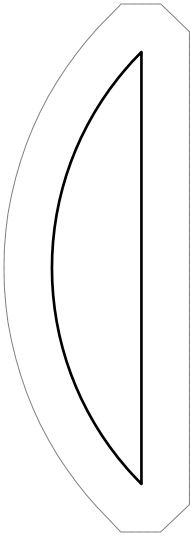
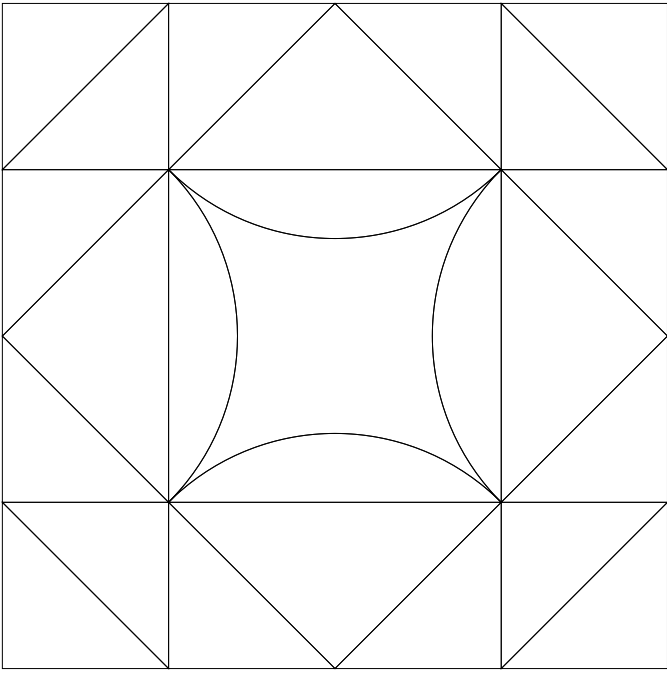
First appliqué the four arcs to the center section (a 3 1/2" square), then use that piece as the center of section B (B1).

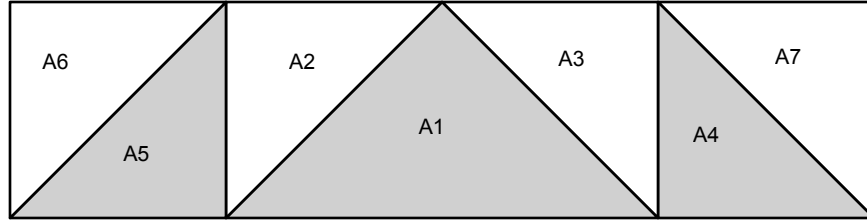


Applique 4 arc shapes to a 3 1/2" square, to be used as the center section B1 in the paper foundation pattern.

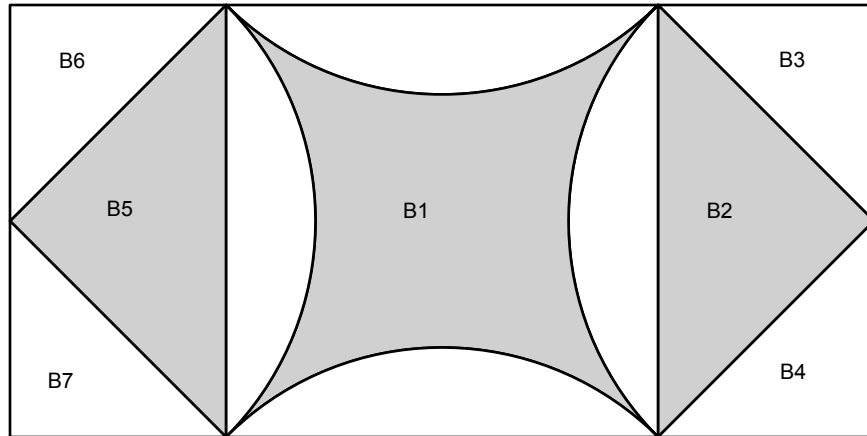

First using the foundation pattern, create the base block, then appliqué the melons to the corners.



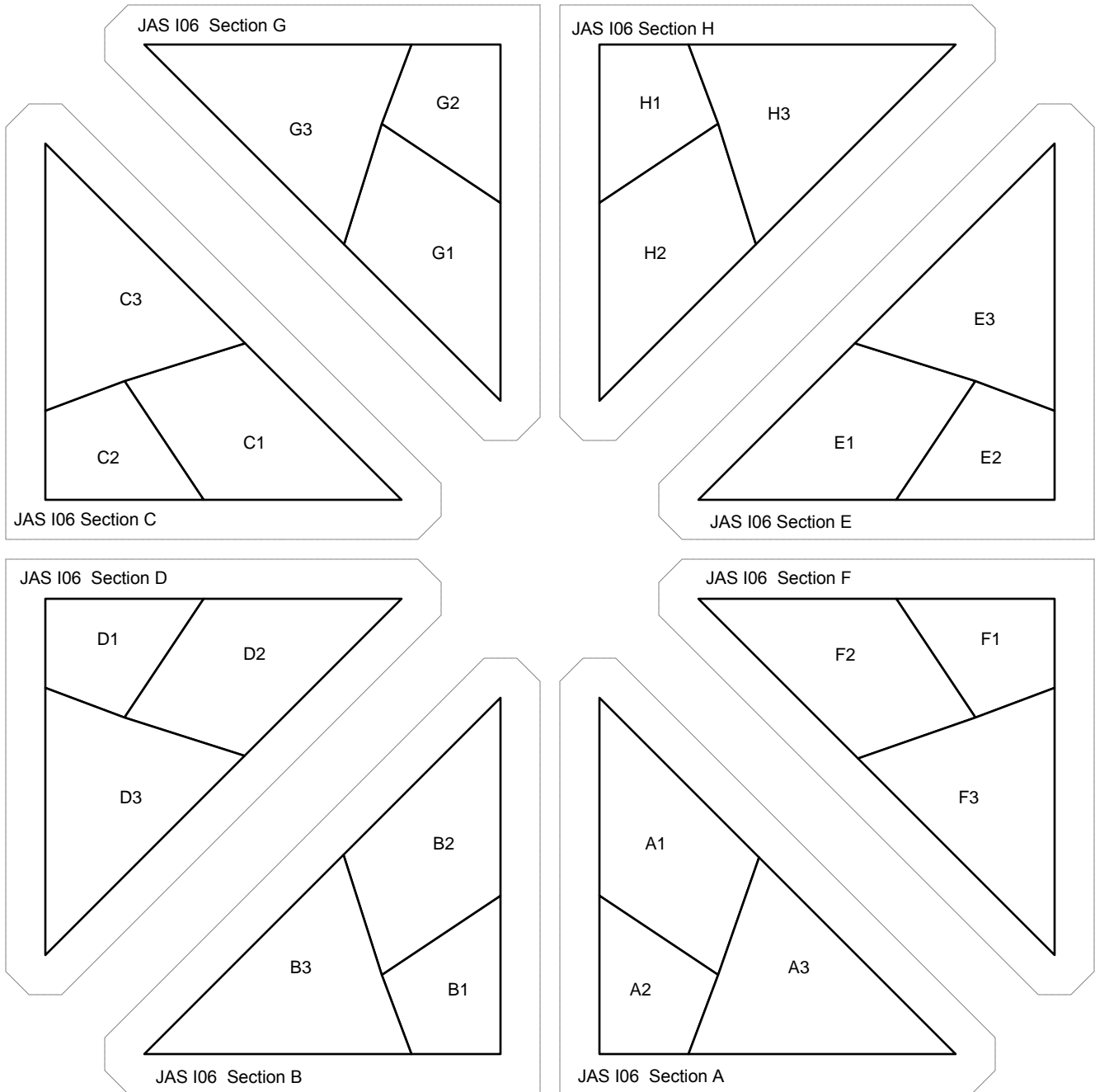

Difficulty Hard

Foundation Piecing

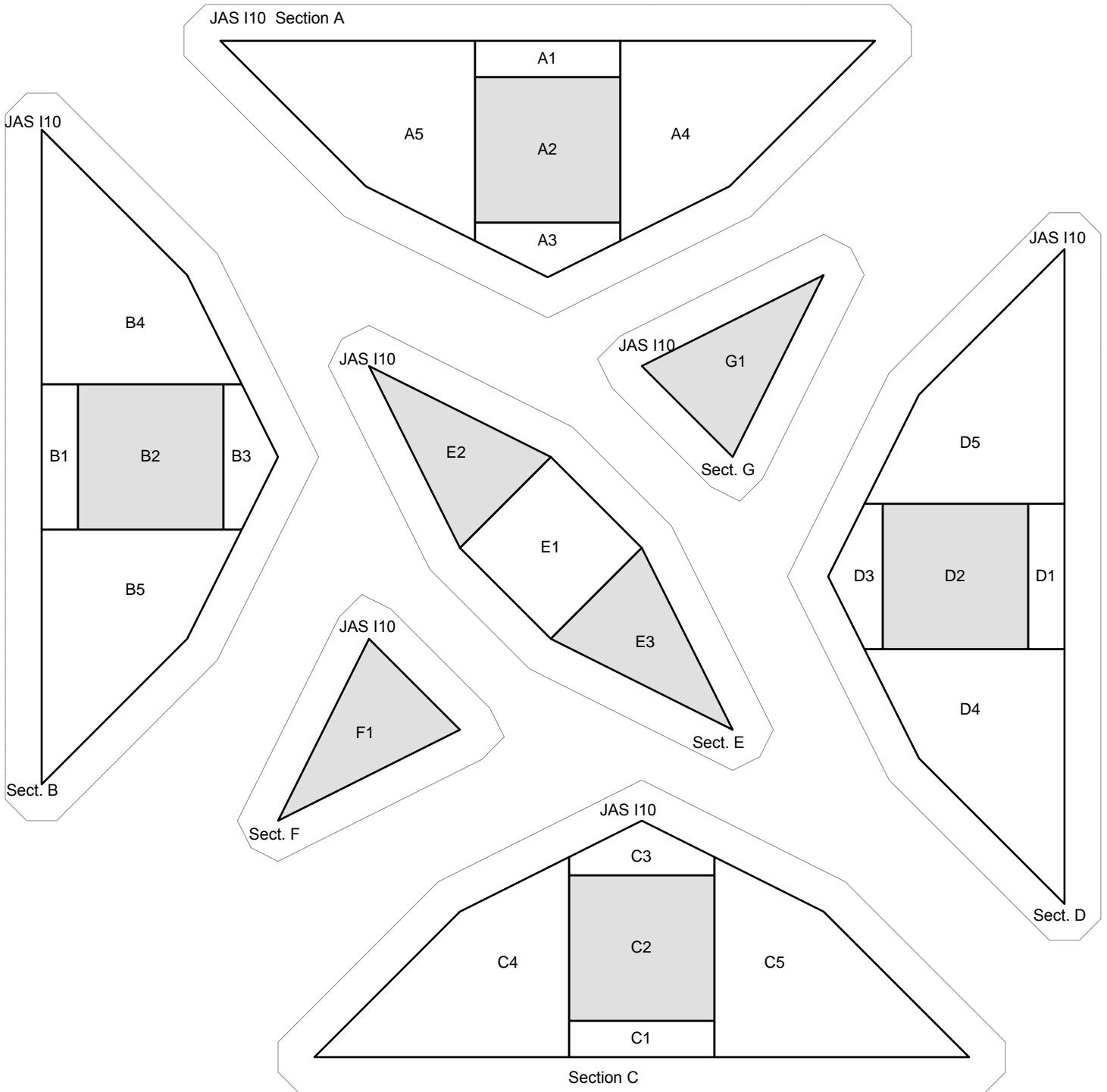
Number of Pieces = 25

The reason I am qualifying this one as "hard", is because of the "Y" seams. First construct the side pieces. Then construct the center section, sewing to the $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Attach the side pieces to the center piece and finally stitch the corner sections together. Remember, just do a section at a time. Don't think of it as hard, think of it as challenging. After all the paper foundation blocks you have done, I KNOW you can do this one.
