Number of Pieces = 12

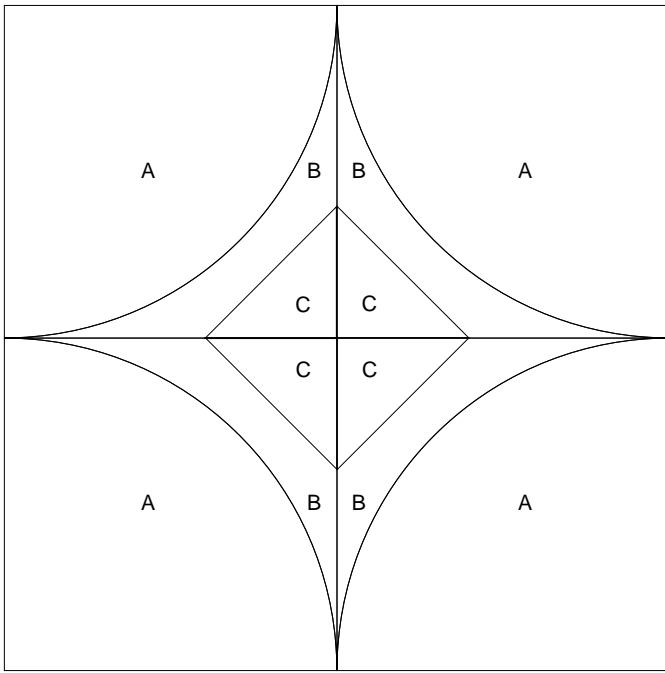
Assemble $\frac{1}{4}$ of the square by sewing A to B. It is a gentle curve, so it will be easy to sew. Then sew C to the A-B piece, flip and sew method. Make 4, sew them together as a four patch, to create your block.



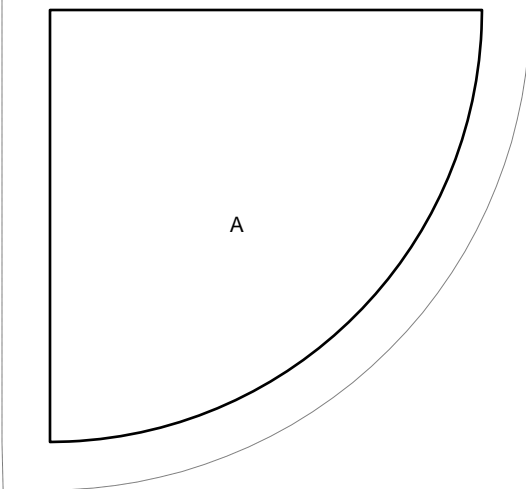
