
First appliqué the four arcs to the center section (a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square), then use that piece as the center of section B (B1).



The reason I am qualifying this one as "hard", is because of the "Y" seams. First construct the side pieces. Then construct the center section, sewing to the ¼" seam allowance. Attach the side pieces to the center piece and finally stitch the corner sections together. Remember, just do a section at a time. Don't think of it as hard, think of it as challenging. After all the paper foundation blocks you have done, I KNOW you can do this one.
